

## **Minutes of Barton Parish Council Meeting held on 30<sup>th</sup> March 2006 in Barton Institute Committee Room.**

Present: Cllr Glithro (acting Chairman), Cllr Dawson, Cllr Hunter, Cllr Burrell-Corey, Kate Proudfoot (Parish Clerk) and 2 members of the public- Mr Dickinson of North Road Farm and Mr Stephenson of Kiln Head Springs.

Mr Dickinson and Mr Stephenson were invited to speak by the Chairman and they voiced their concerns over the proposed quarry and development at Middleton Lodge. Concern was voiced over the amount of dust produced now by the quarry, which will increase with the further development as will the amount of traffic through the village. A discussion was held and it was decided that the best way forward was to send out flyers to each resident advertising the visit to Barton Institute on Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> April by Mr Allinson of Middleton Lodge and encouraging them to attend and ask any questions etc.

It was also decided to make the next council meeting date 27<sup>th</sup> April 2006 the Annual Parish Meeting and invite the electorate to attend and air their concerns. This was also to put on the flyer.

### **Councillor Glithro to attend to the flyer.**

1. Apologies - received from Cllr Thorogood and Cllr McFadzean.
2. Declaration of interest - none received.
3. Minutes of the last meeting held on the 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2006 – **agreed and signed as a true record.**
4. Matters arising:
  - 4.1. Tree work commenced Wednesday this week and cheque for survey paid - £620 (item 2.1 Feb 06)
  - 4.2. A Waller cheque received and acknowledged (item 2.2 Feb 06)
  - 4.3. Bench- P Porteous rang clerk to apologise for delay in replying to query re bench and agreed to put the bench in situ and only charge for cost of materials used. Mr Porteous said he would go and have a look at the bench at Cllr Dawson's residence.
  - 4.4. BVI – Letter received back from Sheena Spence re the Charity Commission and letter was written and sent to CC and await their reply. Also grant application form was sent in with a couple of quotes and M Charlton's survey of the Institute though Sheena is not hopeful for this year.
  - 4.5. Middleton Lodge- Mr Allinson to address residents at the Village Institute on the 9<sup>th</sup> April 2006 re Middleton Lodge proposed development. See above.
5. Chairman's/Clerks items:
  - 5.1. Chairman – sign declaration of office. Oversight on clerks behalf, though Chairman Cllr Thorogood not present.
  - 5.2. Tree in front of Peter Hall's residence – Mr Hall wrote to the PC re the state of a tree directly in front of his property (3 Marygate) and causing his drive to lift. - **Cllr Glithro to have a word with the arborists tomorrow re the tree.**

- 5.3. Annual Parish Meeting- **see above** - Annual Meeting of the Parish Council – **2 weeks after the APM Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> May 2006. Clerk to write to various groups requesting annual report.**
- 5.4. Burns Depot (item 3.4 Feb 06)- Andrew Purkiss contacted clerk re an approach made to him by a Dave Bellerby whom he knows and trusts who is trying to purchase the depot from Mr Burnside/Harriss. The question A Purkiss wished to know was if BPC were willing to grant this developer a deed of easement on the same terms - £27.5K? – **The council proposed that we would ask for the original £30K with the proviso that if the deal is completed within a month BPC would be prepared to accept the £27.5K. The clerk to contact A Purkiss tomorrow with the offer.**
- 5.5. BVI Insurance & Vat return on bill for repairs. - **Clerk sought advice from Ian Strong at YLCA re the paying of the bill from the BVI and reclaiming the VAT back and was strongly advised that this was not advisable or legal especially given the situation with the Charity Commission at the moment.**
- 5.6. Dog Waste bins- apparently are 2 bins in this condition & RDC wish to charge BPC a fee of £25 per bin to clean them out. Cllr Dawson has contacted the department & come up with himself removing the bin section from the poles & taking them to be cleaned for £10 each – **Cllrs Dawson & Hunter to complete this task.**
- 5.7. Melsonby First Response Team- asking for donation and volunteers from Barton – **no money available for donation and notice to be placed on board re volunteers.**
- 5.8. RDC –Sustainable Communities Survey- **completed by Chairman.**
- 5.9. CE Electric UK – Dedicated phone line to be used during prolonged loss of power etc – **Cllr Dawson advised that Rydale covers us.**
- 5.10. YLCA- Website. **User name etc given to Councillors.**
- 5.11. A1 – available funding- **copy given to Marty Gibb.**
- 5.12. 30MPH Sign Church Lane- letter received from NYCC re this and also the requested prohibition for Marygate and both have been turned down. – **Copy of letter to be sent to Mrs Rowbotham and Cllr Hunter to phone NYCC & voice his concerns re Church Lane both as Cllr & Barton resident.**
- 5.13. Emergency Plan- **clerk to remind Cllr Thorogood over issue.**
- 5.14. Speed limit Marygate- see above item 5.12.
- 5.15. Ballot NYCC- Richmondshire Area Committee- election of reps - **ballot paper returned.**
